Qualifications	:	By promotion on the basis of experience and merit of other employees, having assisted a Tradesman for at least two years and who: (i) have a technical knowledge of the work carried out in the workshop or site of work; and (ii) have passed a Trade Test in the relative field.

An equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board.

Duties	:	1. To use and keep in good condition the tools in general use in the trade including electrical instruments, and to have a working knowledge of, and to be able to use in a satisfactory manner, testing instruments used in connection with his work e.g. Megger, Voltmeter and Ammeter. 2. To install internal wiring of all types including conduit and lead covered systems on electric lighting and power installations. 3. To diagnose, locate and remove faults on electric lighting and power installations. 4. To renew fuses, etc, and made and solder all types of conductor joints used in electric lighting and power installation. 5. To read and understand simple wiring diagrams. 6. Routine checks for: (i) emergency lights and RCDs; (ii) diesel generator; (iii) forklifts; and (iv) Fire Hose Reel and water pumps.
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7. Responsible for fitting, fabricating, and assembling the structural components that make up mechanical systems;
8. To repair and service machinery;
9. Carry out correctly the necessary measurements and calculations of the trade, use and keep in good order all tools, simple gauges and appliances appertaining to the trade;
10. Basic plumbing intervention and repairs;
11. Carpentry works, inter alia, repairs of doors, table, chair, etc;
12. Metal works and welding;
13. Basic Civil and Masonry works;
14. Painting works;
15. Assist service providers during servicing, intervention and reparation; and
16. To perform such other duties directly related to the main duties listed above or related to the delivery of the output and results expected from the Tradesman in the roles ascribed to him/her.

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
